

Dark Revelations

Part 7: The Difference Between Light and Dark Revelations

How can we tell the difference between Light and dark revelations?

In order to stay free from the influence of the dark revelations that are being poured out in this hour, we must know the Light of the Truth and stay [reside, dwell, keep on] in the Light of the Truth.

Light revelations draw us to Christ and His Word, which cannot be separated. Dark revelation separates us from Christ *and His Word*

First, Light revelations *always* draw us closer to Jesus Christ, enabling us to “know Him [Jesus Christ] and His Word better. Ephesians 1:17-21 AMP, one of my favorite passages of Scripture reads: “*For I always pray to] the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, that He may grant you a spirit of wisdom and revelation [of insight into mysteries and secrets] in the [deep and intimate] knowledge of Him, ¹⁸by having the eyes of your heart flooded with light, so that you can know and understand the hope to which He has called you, and how rich is His glorious inheritance in the saints (His set-apart ones), ¹⁹and [so that you can know and understand] what is the immeasurable and unlimited and surpassing greatness of His power in and for us who believe, as demonstrated in the working of His mighty strength, ²⁰which He exerted in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His [own] right hand in the heavenly [places], ²¹far above all rule and authority and power and dominion and every name that is named [above every title that can be conferred], not only in this age and in this world, but also in the age and the world which are to come.”*

Ephesians 1:17 tells us that Holy Spirit who is the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation is given to us that “*we may know Him [Christ] better.*” Light revelations always move us towards knowing Him better!

Dark revelations will not cause one to “know Christ better.” This is a sign. If the revelation does not cause you to love, know and understand Jesus Christ on a greater scale--then run from it.

Second, Jesus is the Word (John 1:1) and He will never come against His Word. Jesus is the whole Word of God—the Bible. Therefore, the Bible is God’s Word and the Word of Christ to us. It was written by human authors, under the supernatural guidance of the Holy Spirit. It is the supreme source of truth for Christian beliefs and living. Because it is inspired by God, it is the truth without any mixture of error. Any revelation we get or receive must be in complete alignment with the Word of God—the Bible. As mentioned earlier, dark revelations will or can contain a portion of truth which is twisted containing a mixture of error.

In dark revelations, the Person of Christ—as the Son of God and the only way to the Father will be in question or vague; His mission and work on the Cross will be in question or vague; His Second Coming will be in question or vague and of course, His Word will be in question and vague.

In Light revelations, all of these will become very clear as we come to “know Him better.”

“The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God,” (2 Corinthians 4:4).

Part 8: How To Keep From Dark Revelations

“I am not ashamed of the Gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile. For in the gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, . . .”

(Romans 1:16-17a)

What I am about to tell you is not “new revelation” but it is Godly instruction towards safety that every Believer needs to take serious and DO:

1. **Know Jesus Christ as Savior and LORD.** Be born-again (John 3:3; 3:7) and become a true disciple of Christ Jesus (Matthew 28:19). This is no time for guessing games. If you were saved when you were 5 years old and have lived away from Christ since then—it’s time to be born-again and grow in true discipleship.

You must KNOW the first and only true LIGHT.

2. **Be filled with the Holy Spirit** (Ephesians 5:18). Every Christian needs to have a close relationship with Holy Spirit. Receive the Baptism in the Holy Spirit!

Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Truth (John 15:26; 16:13) and the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation (Eph. 1:17). Many Christians in the past have fought the Person, knowledge, and power of the Holy Spirit. That needs to end because He is our life-line to the Godhead and the one who leads us into all truth.

Holy Spirit is the One who gives us true discernment. Discernment is actually *discerning of spirits* where one is able to tell if a spirit is of or from God or of or from the devil. A true spirit of discernment comes from a manifestation gift of Holy Spirit.

We must be filled with the Spirit Who is our Protector from dark revelations.

3. **Read, meditate study, learn, and know the Word of God.** Since revelation is directly related to Christ and His Word—the only sure way to keep from being taken into these dark revelations is the Word of God—the true Revelation of Light. Prayer, as many know it to be and take part in, will not necessarily keep anyone from coming under the influence of dark revelations. Fasting will not necessarily keep anyone from coming under the influence of dark revelations. Praise and worship will not necessarily keep anyone from coming under the influence of dark revelations. Every Christian needs to be in and know the Word of God for him or herself.

Every Christian needs to KNOW and UNDERSTAND the Word of God. This is no time for “not having time to get into God’s Word.

Knowing and understanding the Word of God is the only way to Faith, healing, deliverance, abundance, power, authority, peace, joy and more—we know this. But do we know and understand that the Word is what keeps us from the grips of satan? It wasn’t a trite thing that Jesus defeated satan with the power of the Word while in the desert—and it will be no trite thing for us. We will overcome dark revelations with the power of the Word just as Jesus did.

2 Peter 1:4—*“His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. ⁴ Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature and escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires. ⁵ For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; ⁶ and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; ⁷ and to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love. ⁸ For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.”*

4. **Decide to walk in righteousness and holiness.** What is righteousness? Right-ness according to God. We all have our own ideas of what is right, but that needs to change. We need to know and obey what God says is right.

Be righteous (Romans 5:19).

What is holiness? Being set apart—for God. How many Christians today are not “setting themselves and their lives apart for God?

Be holy (1 Peter 1:16).

Righteousness and holiness will protect us from dark revelations.

5. **Do not be a Lone Ranger.** *Submit and commit* yourself to being a member or part of the true Body of Christ—connected to and in active fellowship with a local church—that teaches the whole Light of Truth and who will love them and help keep you safe through loving interaction, instruction, teaching, discipleship, healing, correction, rebuke and exhortation. Lone Rangers are always susceptible and prime targets to dark revelations. *“Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching,”* (Hebrews 10:25).

Part 9: Get in the Light and Be light!

“God is light; in Him there is no darkness at all. ⁶ If we claim to have fellowship with him yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live by the truth. ⁷ But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin,” (1 John 1:5-7).

“You are the light of the world,” (Matthew 5:14).

The LORD says, *“You must increase in My LIGHT now. My Light is the only Light that will dispel the dark revelations.”*

Isaiah 60:1-2—*“Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD rises upon you.*

² *See, darkness covers the earth and thick darkness is over the peoples, but the LORD rises upon you and His glory appears over you.”*

When we increase in the Light of Christ, we are increasing in truth and knowledge of God.

The Light of Christ is our ONLY safety/protection against dark revelations. We will not recognize or be free from the influence of dark revelations unless we are in the LIGHT of Christ Jesus. To the level that we are in *His Light*--is to the level we will have little fear of the influences of dark revelations. On the other hand, to the level we are NOT in His Light--will be the level dark revelations will have influence over us.

We are to also “be light!” When we’re letting the Light of Christ shine through us—we are being a mirror image of Him to the world and obeying His commands. This is safety!

The LORD says, “You must increase in love and faith for these are the “light connections” to My TRUTH. It is only through love and faith that you will find truth. Love releases ability to hear and see correctly. Faith sees through His eyes what cannot be seen in the natural. Truth, produced out of love and faith, verifies as indisputable fact the reality of God, His Word, and His Kingdom. These three produce solid ground in us.

The trinity of love, faith and truth will create the Light of Christ in us and cause the Spirit of wisdom and revelation to be upon us and move us into His truth. Any ingredient of these three missing, can cause big problems with revelation.
